



Pick Your Holiday

TABLE TOPPER

Finished Size - Aprox. 40 x 40"

Fabric

Center block and corner blocks - 5/8 yd

Center corner triangles, corner blocks, outside border and binding - 1 1/4 yds

Side panels - 1/2 yd For directional fabric 5/8 yd

Inside border - 1/4 yd

Backing - 2 1/4 yd

Directions

Center block – Cut 14" square


Center corner triangles – Cut 2 10 - 1/2" squares, then cut once across the diagonal.

Sew the triangles to sides of center block. Press. Sew the other triangles at remaining sides of the center block. Press. Square up unit to measure 14" square. Be mindful of your points!

Cut 4 side panels 8" x 19 1/2". Sew panel to top and bottom of center block. DO NOT sew the side panels until the corner blocks are finished.

Pinwheel Blocks (makes 2 blocks)


Cut 4 squares of fabric A and 4 squares of fabric B, each measuring 4-5/8 inches. Cut across diagonal to make a total of 16 half triangles.



Sew one A to one B together across the diagonal, being careful not to stretch! Make 8 units. Assemble as shown. Press. Square to 8".

Four-Patch Block (makes 2 blocks)

Cut 4 squares of fabric A and 4 squares of fabric B, each 4 1/4" square. Sew one A to on B. Make 4 units. Assemble as shown to make two blocks. Press. Square up to 8".



Attach corner blocks to the tops and bottoms of the two 8 x 9 1/2" panels as shown in the photo on page 1. Attach these strips to the sides of the center assembled block.

Inside Border

Cut 4 strips WOF 2" wide. Sew strip to top and bottom of center assembled unit. Press and trim ends even with center unit. Sew strip to each side. Trim. Press.

Outside Border

Cut 4 strips WOF 2 1/2" wide. Sew strip to top and bottom. Press and trim even with center unit. Sew strip to each side. Trim. Press.

Quilt as desired. Bind. You can do it!
